



Fehmarnbelt Fixed Link, Bridge Design, Denmark

Services provided

Design planning of a cable-stayed bridge or suspension bridge with double-track electrified railway line and four-lane road connection in Joint Venture with COWI A/S

Technical details

The Fehmarnbelt is an approx. 19 kilometer wide strait between the south Danish island of Lolland and the German island of Fehmarn. In June 2007 the governments of Germany and Denmark agreed on a joint project for the crossing of the Fehmarnbelt. Based on the preliminary and design planning it will be decided whether a bridge or an immersed tunnel is to be built.
